## Introduction

- Galicia: NW corner of Spain, 6% of the country and the longest coastline.
- Most important sectors: wood industry and food industry.
- Other sectors: automotive industry, naval industry, renewable energy and biotechnology.
- In this context, the Galician government is diversifying the Economy through the aeronautical sector















### The Civil UAVs Initiative

 A strategic initiative led by Galician government with the participation of all departments.

# Objectives:

- Socio-economic objectives: Increasing regional economic growth in Galicia
- Innovation policy objectives: RIS3 includes development of aeronautical sector.
- Functional and technical objectives: Increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of public services provided by Galician Government based on UAVs.
















# **Budget and Financing**

 Total budget: 150M€, 50% public funding & 50% private funding.

# Public budget:

- 40M€ for Pre-commercial Procurement (PCP) dedicated to R&D program. Phase I
- 10M€ infraestructure. Phase I
- 24M€ for Public Procurement Innovation (PPI), dedicated to innovation/solutions program. Phase II

#### Private funds

75M€ for the R&D Common Program. Phase I
















### **Instruments**

- Pre-commercial Procurement (PCP) for the selection of 1-2 strategic partners to develop a common R&D program.
- Public Procurement Innovation (PPI) to achieve new solutions for the improvement of public services through UAVs.
- Innovation Partnerships.
















### **Authorities and roles**

- **Financing autorities:** European Commission (ERDF), Spanish Ministry of Economy, Industry and Competitiveness, 2 regional agencies (Gain, Igape).
- Initiative management: Galician Innovation Agency (Gain).
- Implementing actors: Spanish National Institute for Aerospace Tecnology (INTA), private actors selected through PCP (Indra and Babcock).
- Contracting authorities: Galician Government and INTA.
- Technology users: all the departments of the regional government.
















## **Practical case: the PCP Contract**

  - How to receive a proposal with real impact in the region?


